This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. From a liturgical point of view, today marks the end of the Christmas season and the beginning of Ordinary Time. Indeed, this is a feast about transition. In Jesus' life, this event marks the beginning of his public ministry. As he emerges from the liminal space of the waters of the Jordan River, the doorway to heaven is thrown open and the Holy Spirit descends upon him 'like a dove' — a reference to the flood story in Genesis, where the return of the dove confirms for Noah that God's work of re-creation has begun. Jesus comes to make a new humanity — and so all humanity stands at the threshold, awaiting the work of grace.

This weekend our community welcomes a number of people to the waters of baptism — to share in the Lord's baptism and in his mission. Others will be confirmed and welcomed into full communion with the Church. This will be a special moment for each of them, but it can serve as a moment of renewal for us as well.

Let us pray, then, that today the Lord will throw open the doorway to heaven; that through the grace of these sacraments, those who receive them today, and those who have already received them, may be truly transformed. May we receive, in its fullness, the presence and power of the Spirit, and be moved to live lives of holiness, service and joy, and, by God's grace, bring change to our world. May we see in Christ our leader on the pilgrimage of life, the Beloved of the Father. And may we recognise that in Baptism and Confirmation we too have been anointed by the Spirit, and that through the ministry of the Church we can hear the voice of the Father say to each of us: you too are my beloved; my favour rests on you.
